

Terms and Conditions for EnerTracks Online Training

Please check the box “I agree” in the online application form to consent to these terms.

EnerTracks–Training Climate and Energy Transformation Experts for Tomorrow is an online training programme that offers scholarships to a limited number of participants to complete the programme. A scholarship is a form of financial aid to support a participant’s education. It is the responsibility of RENAC to ensure that participants who receive scholarships as well as those who do not receive scholarships successfully complete the training programme. To ensure this, RENAC accepts the most eligible applicants into the programme. By submitting an application to EnerTracks, applicants agree to the terms and conditions in this document.

I, the applicant, hereby agree with the following statements.

Scholarship-funded participation

- RENAC grants as many scholarships as possible to eligible applicants. Therefore, RENAC is responsible for defining the eligibility criteria for participation.
- Submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance into the programme. Programme admission decisions made by RENAC are final and will not be reconsidered.
- Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. Therefore, it is highly recommended that applicants submit a detailed motivation letter that highlights relevant experiences and how this programme will support career advancement.
- RENAC will inform applicants whether they have been granted a scholarship for the online training via email as soon as possible.

Self-funded participation

- Promising applicants who do not receive scholarships may be offered a self-funded spot in the training programme. This decision will be made solely at RENAC’s discretion.
- Applicants offered a self-funded place in the programme must pay RENAC €300 prior to the start of the training programme. Mode of payment and payment deadline information will be sent to these participants directly via email.
- Submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance into the programme. Programme admission decisions by RENAC are final and cannot be reconsidered.

Account deactivation or cancellation

- Applicants accepted into the EnerTracks Online Training agree to participate in the above-mentioned training programme and perform all required activities (e.g. reading module material, attending virtual classroom sessions, and completing exercises and exams).
- Should participants fail to participate in the modules or fail to comply with the related responsibilities, RENAC will send a participation reminder via email. RENAC is entitled to

deactivate any participant's account if, within two weeks of receiving such a reminder, no attendance can be verified in the EnerTracks Online Training.

- Participants who received a scholarship and do not participate in EnerTracks will have to pay €300 for non-attendance, despite having been granted a scholarship.
- In the event of sudden illness or force majeure, participants awarded scholarships who need to withdraw from the training programme must inform RENAC immediately via email (enertracks@renac.de) and enclose a medical certificate or another valid written confirmation stating the reasons for the failed attempt to participate in the online training. In such cases, the participant will not be required to pay the costs for the online training.

Liability and force majeure

- RENAC will not be liable for any damages so long as they resulted from an upcoming, unforeseeable, and unavoidable event, which is not attributable to RENAC.
- RENAC shall not be liable for any damages arising from a substantial change in the prevailing circumstances at the time of acceptance of these terms and conditions that may affect the completion of the EnerTracks Online Training.
- The information, data, and other components of the training material have been obtained from carefully selected sources and have been compiled to the best of Renewables Academy AG's knowledge. However, Renewables Academy AG does not guarantee its accuracy or completeness, and nothing in this document should be construed as such a guarantee.
